



Local Hero, Dick Hambleton, Inspiration to Us All!

At 91, **Dick Hambleton** continues to amaze and inspire many. He shows no signs of slowing down either. "He has given so much to Fieldstone Farm. It's truly incredible." **Lynnette Stuart**, Executive Director, says of Dick, who will celebrate 25 years of volunteering at Fieldstone Farm in 2012.

Dick started volunteering at the Farm in 1987 as a riding lesson volunteer. He had just retired from his career as a chemical engineer and was looking for a way to share his love of horses. A regular fixture at Fieldstone Farm, he has helped train and prepare horses for lessons, served in classes as a sidewalker and leader and was even a member of Fieldstone Farm's drill team in the 1990's. Today, he typically serves as an able-bodied whip in carriage driving lessons helping students learn to drive.

Over the years, he has worked with many of our students helping them achieve what they never thought possible. For some, it meant speaking for the first time, for others it meant gaining the strength to walk, and others, it meant building the confidence to inspire them to do more in their daily lives. Driving instructor, **Debbie Gadus**, whom Dick mentored as a student and now serves in her classes, says "Dick helps students accomplish as much as they can by gently nudging and encouraging them. He is a wonderful person."

Dick also participates in many fundraisers for Fieldstone Farm. On October 2nd, he rode 20 miles in the annual Ride-A-Thon. "This is an endurance feat for any rider, let alone a 91-year-old," says Development Director **Maureen Foster**. "Dick is truly amazing, an inspiration to us



all.

Dick's record of service includes: serving in the U.S. Army during WWII, 'Top 10' Volunteer status for at least a decade at Fieldstone Farm and being awarded the 1999 Regional Volunteer of the Year from **Path Intl.** (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International). When he is not busy at Fieldstone Farm, Dick also serves as a member of the **Lake Metroparks Volunteer Mounted Posse**, patrolling trails, conducting demonstrations, training the horses, and riding in parades and the Posse Color Guard.

Under the new leadership of Principal **Lindsay Baar**, Gaitway High School has begun this school year with a bang. The nontraditional public high school helps students who have been unable to be successful in their typical high schools by capitalizing on the Farm environment to support them in achieving their goals. The eighteen students currently enrolled, nine of whom are new to the program this year, have already settled in and made exciting steps forward.

Juniors and seniors spend their afternoons at Punderson State Park, Schneider's Saddlery and Heinen's in job training programs, while younger students get vocational education hours by helping to take care of job-related tasks on-site at Fieldstone Farm. Nearly all of the students are active volunteers in Fieldstone Farm's riding classes—from leading horses to sidewalking to helping in classrooms—and are continuing to demonstrate their growing maturity and competency around horses.
