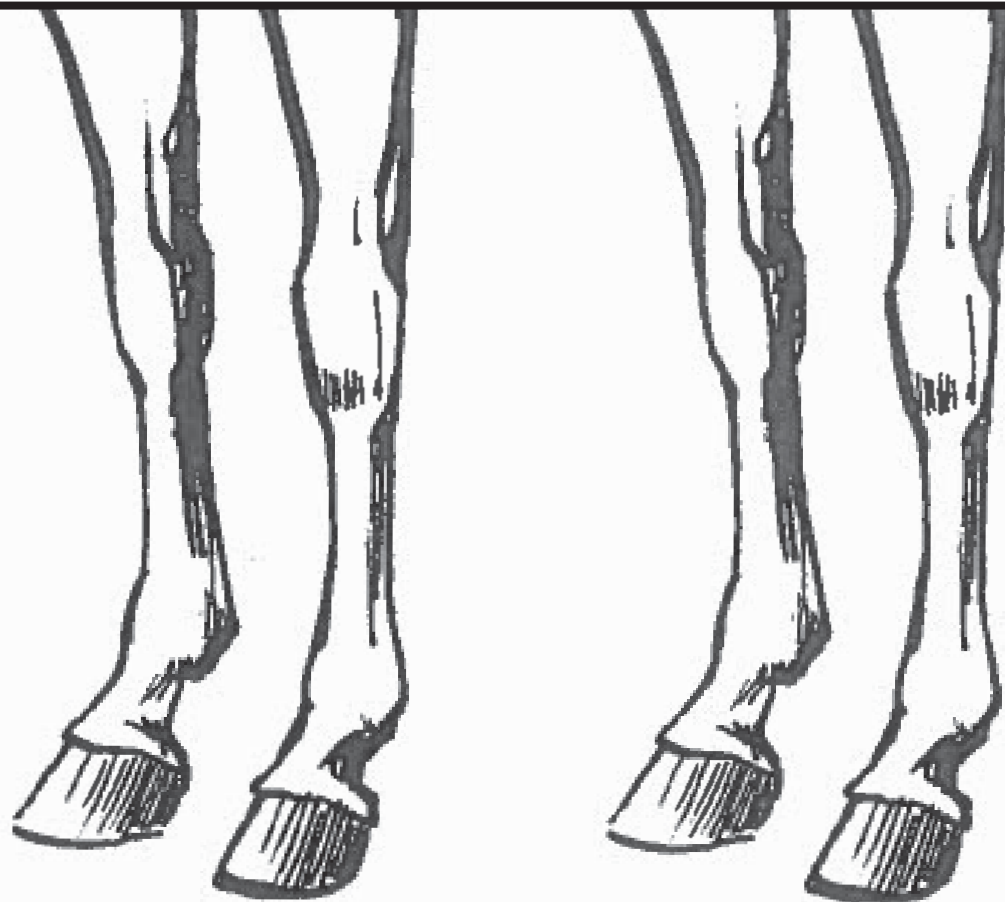


# Putting On Socks

Horses can have a variety of distinguishable leg markings. Try your hand at drawing on the patterns identified below. Put one marking on each leg.



Draw a coronet marking: A white marking around the coronet band.

Draw a pastern marking: A white marking to the ankle, or fetlock.

Draw a sock: A white marking extending over the fetlock and partway up the cannon bone.

Draw a stocking: A white marking that extends up the cannon bone, often going up to or over the knee or hock.
